

## CPHS Dance Boosters Scholarship Application

1. Fully completed scholarship application (submit in Word or PDF format).
2. Scanned copy of their current CPHS transcript.

Each applicant must be a graduating senior. Celebrities, Luminaries, Honor Guard and managers are eligible for scholarships. Only one scholarship will be awarded to an applicant.

CPHS Dance Booster Scholarship Program will start accepting applications on March 10, 2024. Applications and supporting documents due by EOD (11:59pm) on April 5, 2024. Applications received after the deadline, or applications with incomplete or missing information, are not eligible for consideration.

Scholarship Review Committee Chair will de-identify the application packets. Application packets will be reviewed by the Scholarship Committee members and scored as follows.
